Talbert House Recognizing Opiate Awareness Week

CINCINNATI— From September 17 through 23 Talbert House, and community partners will recognize Opiate Awareness Week in Over-the-Rhine (OTR). Rhinegeist will be generously donating a portion of their sales from the week to Talbert House and the Agency’s various addiction treatment programs in an effort to combat the opiate epidemic that continues to impact our area. Other supporters include Findlay Market, Pedal Wagon, and OTR Chamber.

An opioid prevention training session will be held in OTR on Thursday, September 20. This training will provide guidance and instruction on how to administer the lifesaving drug, naloxone, also known as Narcan®. The medication will be furnished to all training session attendees.
