


# Talbert House Receives Commitment Award

# **OTP & ACA Accreditation**

The Opioid Treatment Program (OTP) received a three-year accreditation for its Outpatient Substance Use Disorder Treatment (Adult) and Intensive Outpatient Substance Use Disorder Treatment (Adult) services. This accreditation, the first awarded to OTP since joining Talbert House, represents the highest level of recognition by CARF. It reflects dedication to delivering measurable, accountable, and high-quality programs and services.



Additionally, four of Talbert House's Court & Corrections programs received three-year accreditation renewals at the American Correctional Association (ACA) conference. Following audits in October and November, presentations were made to the Accreditation Panel for review, leading to final renewal approvals.
