Programs

SOBER INDEPENDENT LIVING

Sober housing offers peer support, community service groups and connections to the community for individuals with substance use disorders in active recovery.

- Section Center** - For men in Hamilton County
- 2640 Victory Parkway** - For men, women and families in Hamilton County
- Vine Street** - For men in Hamilton County

SHELTER HOUSING

- Health Care for Homeless Veterans (HCHV) CERs**
Providing VA Medically Eligible Veterans and their families with shelter, food, transportation, and case management.
 - » Referrals are made by Central Access Point (513-381-7233)

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

- Doan Street**
Provides transitional housing to single men and women in Warren and Clinton Counties.
 - » Referrals must be approved by the Warren/Clinton County MHRBS
- Parkway Center**
Transitional housing center for homeless men and women in Hamilton County with substance use disorders. Offers substance use services, mental health and case management to assist in finding permanent housing and employment.
 - » Referrals are made through Central Access Point (513-381-7233) or by contacting the site at (513-661-4620)

PREVENTION

- Innovative Prevention Project (IPP)**
Provides short term targeted Case Management and financial assistance to Hamilton County Residents who are low income and at risk of eviction
 - » Referrals are submitted directly to Program Supervisor Kaylie.Wood@talberthouse.org

SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

- Community Transition Program (CTP) & Returning Home Ohio (RHO)**
Permanent Supportive Housing and Rapid Rehousing for individuals in Hamilton, Warren and Clermont Counties returning from an Ohio prison, who are HIV Positive, or who participated in mental health and/or recovery services while incarcerated.
 - » Referrals are made by the Corporation for Supportive Housing

Family Care Homes

- Adult care homes that provide housing, supervision, and services to individuals with serious mental illness.
 - » Referrals are made through Central Connection (513-588-6601)

Permanent Supportive Housing

- Permanent supportive housing with case management services for formerly homeless persons in Hamilton County with a history of substance use and/or mental health disabilities. Offers rental and housing assistance through housing subsidies and search assistance.
 - » Referrals are made through Coordinated Entry

Rapid Re-Housing Progressive Engagement

- Provides short-term rental assistance and case management to adults experiencing homelessness in Hamilton County.
 - » Referrals are made through Coordinated Entry

Rental Assistance Program

- Provides rental and/or utility assistance to Hamilton County resident with a minor in the household and at risk of eviction.
 - » Referrals are made by Hamilton County Job and Family Services
 - » Applications for rental assistance can be submitted online at erap.hcjfs.org

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

- Serves single veterans and families with a veteran head of household in the Hamilton County and 9 surrounding counties in Indiana, Ohio, and Kentucky. Provides case management services and temporary financial assistance.
 - » Veteran household must have an Other than Dishonorable Discharge, be low-income, and be homeless or at risk of homelessness
 - » Hamilton County referrals are coordinated through Central Access Point (513-381-7233)
